#### School Vision & Values

#### Attendance

Full attendance and punctuality are key factors in helping our young people to be successful. These are skills that last a life time. If your child has to attend a medical appointment this should be made out-with the school day and where this is not possible a copy of the appointment should be shared with the school via the school office.

If your child is ill or unable to attend school for any reason you must contact the absence line on **OI41 287 0039** on the first day of absence. If your child continues to be absent you must call the line each day or provide an estimated return date. If we do not know why your child is absent you will receive a call or text.

To make sure you receive the right support you require, parents and carers should still contact the school directly to report absences of a sensitive or personal nature, for example:

- Bereavement
- Serious illness, for example, an absence which is going to last more than one week
- Injury, for example, broken limb
- Contagious diseases or illness

#### School Uniform

Our pupils have returned to school looking extremely smart in their new school uniforms. We work hard to ensure this continues throughout the year and plan to do this once again. We would appreciate it if all parents and carers could ensure all items of clothing and footwear are **clearly labelled** to ensure that if any are misplaced they can be returned promptly to their owners. #### Parents Portal

Parents Portal is designed to replace the 'schoolbag run' and provides online access to a range of school related services to parents/carers.

It will provide access to Parents/Carers with information about school and will allow 24-hour online access to:

- Complete/update the annual data check process electronically
- Update their own as well as their child's details at any time
- View the school calendar
- Complete electronic permission slips and consent forms

As the Parents Portal develops, you will see more services being introduced in the future including online placing requests, report cards, payments for trips and activities.

#### Car Parking

I would like to remind all adults to park safely away from the school and walk with their children to the gates. Parents and carers are kindly asked not to use the staff car park for picking up and dropping off. Thank you for your support with this matter.

#### Exiting Procedures

Thank you so much for your support in maintaining our exit procedures at 3pm. PI-P3 will exit from our Infant Gate and P4-P7 will exit from the Senior Gate. Your co-operation with keeping the Infant Gate area clear following our 'pick up & go'advice and P4-P7 pupils exiting from the Senior Gate is appreciated. Children with a younger sibling can leave through their sibling's gate.

#### Whole School Soft Start

All children are encouraged to go straight in to class from **8.50am** to get ready for the day and of course enjoy some 'play' and social time with their friends as well as fun challenges. Any children entering after **9.00am** should enter through the School Office Entrance Hall. Children entering school following the 9am bell will be marked as late.

#### Healthy Snacks

As you are all aware we are a Health and Wellbeing Award winning Primary School and we always recommend a healthy snack! Please be mindful of healthy snacks as we start the new session – fruit, cereal bars, fruit juice and water are welcomed. We encourage our children to drink water throughout the day. Please provide a full water bottle labelled with your child's name for use during the school day and remember no fizzy drinks should be brought into school in line with all Eastbank Learning Community schools.

#### P.E.

As you know we are committed to providing as many sporting experiences for our pupils as possible. We will continue to follow Scottish Government guidance on this. Each class will participate in 2 hours of quality PE lessons each week. PE can be delivered inside or out.

As stated in Master Safety File 34P PE Code of Practice and Risk Assessments the following procedures should be followed:-

- Pupils should change into suitable clothing and footwear for the activity.
- Pupils must not work in stocking soles and bare feet should only be allowed when conditions are suitable.
- Personal effects (e.g. jewellery, body piercing, items of religious significance, watches, hair slides and belts) constitute a hazard and may cause injury if worn whilst participating in Physical Education and must be removed.

We appreciate your support in providing your child with a T-shirt/Polo Shirt, shorts and lightweight sandshoes or trainers (No football colours please). Pupils are invited to bring their kit in a tote bag which can stay in school and be brought home periodically for washing.

It is a good idea to allow children to keep a kit in school as PE days can change throughout the session depending on the availability of Sports Coaches.

#### Administration of Medicines

If your child requires to be given any form of medicine during the school day inclusive of inhalers it is necessary to complete a medical form from the office before we can administer it. <u>All medicines must be</u> <u>labelled with your child's name and the quantity to be given</u> Please also let the office know if your child has stopped / started taking any long-term medicines over the summer period. It is vital that our Health records are kept up to date. Also, we kindly ask that any "3 per day" antibiotics be issued before and after school.



#### Parent Council


